The following bibliography was developed by SLU student Holly Brown '14 during a summer fellowship in Special Collections, Owen D. Young Library, St. Lawrence University with library staff from special collections and digital collections...

In her 1958 bibliography, Dorothy Plum took a broad geographic view of what the "Adirondack" region included. Upon consideration, we have narrowed our definition somewhat. For the purposes of this bibliography an Adirondack poem is

- Set within the administrative boundary of the Park known as the "Blueline"
- Does not include Lake Champlain
- Does not include pre-19th century poetry of the Revolutionary and French and Indian Wars

No bibliography is ever *really* complete, and we view this one as a work-in-progress. We welcome and invite additions, corrections and suggestions from readers, poets, and would-be scholars.
